### **DT: Pneumatics**

In Design and Technology lessons children will be learning about 'Pneumatics' - How air makes things move.

They will be investigating a range of products that use air to make their components move and experimenting with making their own air pressured models.

All children will then design and make their a moving monster or character that uses pneumatics.




